CREDIT COURSES AND PROVINCIAL EXAMINATIONS AUGUST 2009.

Provincial examinations will take place between Aug. 1, and 7, 2009, inclusive. A maximum of two courses may be taken. Courses commence July 13, (see calendar on reverse side) and they terminate on the day of examination. Students must attend all classes.

Classes are small, and students receive individual attention. As a result, the school's record of success has been high.
